Position Summary:

Under indirect guidance of the Maintenance Worker IV performs work of average difficulty assisting in the maintenance of roads; performs related work as required.

Essential Job Functions & Duties and Responsibilities:

- Performs miscellaneous labor jobs connected with road maintenance;
- Unloads trucks hauling maintenance materials;
- Flags traffic; collects trash;
- May operate a two-axle dump truck to haul highway maintenance material;
- May operate wheeled tractors, pulling rollers, patching rollers, compactors, compressors and jack hammers;
- Performs other duties as assigned, i.e. patching, crack sealing, culvert cleaning, brush cutting, tree trimming, weed spraying, etc.

Minimum Job Requirements:

- Arizona Driver License
- Good driving record according to County Policy

Required Knowledge, Skill & Ability:

- Good knowledge of the operating characteristics of light trucks and similar automotive equipment
- Good knowledge of traffic regulations and the practices applied in the care and safe operation of equipment

- Capable of working under direction and with minimal supervision on occasion
- Ability to be deployed to remote areas of the County
- Work in adverse conditions for extended periods of time
- Must be able to lift 50-100 lbs. occasionally, 10-25 lbs. frequently, up to 10-20 lbs. constantly
- Periodically or routinely lift heavy items up to 50 lbs. and carry long distances up to 20 feet
- Bend or stoop repeatedly or continually over time
- Walk over rough, uneven, or rocky surfaces
- Remain in a standing position for extended periods of time.
