Position Description

The City of Tolleson is seeking qualified individuals interested in joining our team as a Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator/Semi, Tractor-Trailer Driver (M&O Utilities Technician). The purpose of this position is to operate and maintain the wastewater treatment facility in accordance with all environmental regulatory laws, rules, and regulations. Responsibilities may include: Operate process equipment in both the liquid and solids treatment streams; recognize equipment/process problems, and following procedures to correct; Collect samples; Conduct routine lab testing; Calculate and adjust chemical dosages; Conduct regular and routine equipment/process inspections and adjustments; Record equipment readings; Data entry; Perform minor maintenance, and other manual labor, including tasks to maintain a clean, safe, and orderly facility; and all other duties as assigned

Qualifications

High School Diploma or equivalent GED; or, an equivalent combination of education and experience sufficient to successfully perform the essential duties of the job such as those listed above. Class A, Commercial Driver's License (CDL), completed a Professional Semi-Tractor Trailer Driving School, and ability to maintain respiratory program requirements for SCBA required. **Possess a Valid Grade 1, Arizona Wastewater Operator Certification, or ability to obtain within two (2) years from date of hire.**

Required Experience:

Driving a Semi-Tractor, with manual transmission, and end dump and/or side dump trailer, within the last 7 years. Operating heavy equipment (Dump Truck, Fork Lifts, Front End Loader, Back Hoe)_Wastewater Treatment Plant Operations.

- Requires the use of SCBA and other personal protective equipment (PPE)

Physical Demands

Positions in this class typically require: climbing, balancing, stooping, kneeling, crouching, crawling, reaching, standing, walking, pushing, pulling, lifting, fingering, grasping, feeling, talking, hearing, seeing and repetitive motions.

Heavy Work: Exerting up to 100 pounds of force occasionally, and/or up to 50 pounds of force frequently, and/or up to 20 pounds of forces constantly to move objects.

Incumbents may be subjected to moving mechanical parts, electrical currents, vibrations, fumes, odors, dusts, gases, poor ventilation, chemicals, oils, blood and other bodily fluids, and extreme temperatures.
